Your best bet is to find a regularly scheduled shuttle and get to the pickup point. Shuttles that pick you up where you want to be picked up are often very expensive.

<http://www.frontrangeexpress.com/> < Front Range Express has a stop at Woodmen and Academy (a few miles north of UCCS) with low cost shuttles to downtown Denver (\$11 one way). Once you're in Denver, you'll have more options to get to the airport with your other \$39. ☺
